Optimal inventory and cost management.

Manage rental equipment inventory; from general monitoring to quantity management and incoming/outgoing inventory. Automatically generate invoices and manage related costs and revenues, based on different usage.

Rental equipment is defined as the material a company holds in inventory, which it sends to projects or rents to a given customer, and is returned to the inventory after being used on projects or by the customer.

Equipment rental features

Rental equipment catalogue

- Catalogue of equipment available for use for internal and external rentals.
- Multi-layer equipment categorization.
- Ability to set a variety of system defaults for various accounting and billing related transactions.
- Ability to track warranty details.
- Ability to attach up to 2 different meters to an equipment record.

Project integration

- Ability to drive internal costs to operational projects and to pull internal revenues back to rented equipment project if desired.
- Ability to separate and track external revenues back to each equipment project.

Billing automation

- Generate equipment rental invoicing based on user selections for 'internal projects' or to the 'external customers' to whom the equipment has been rented.
- Supports multiple rates / equipment + meter billing as well per billing period.
- Allows the billing process to be automated to ensure billing accuracy for each period to be billed.
- Full integration with maestro* ERP sales invoicing module.
- Supports inter-company billing with Multi-Dimensional module installed.
- Provides a billing calendar to ensure all non-billing days are identified to support non-operating days.

Inventory integration

- Full inventory tracking of equipment, by company and site.
- Ability to use requisitions to manage equipment demand.
